

## OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

The **Occupational Therapist** will work in a dynamic interdisciplinary team that provides assessment, programming, in-service and assistive technology support for students with diverse learning needs. This position will include specific focus on ECS children with language delays. Travel within the region is required.

- Experience in clinical assessment
