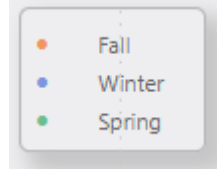

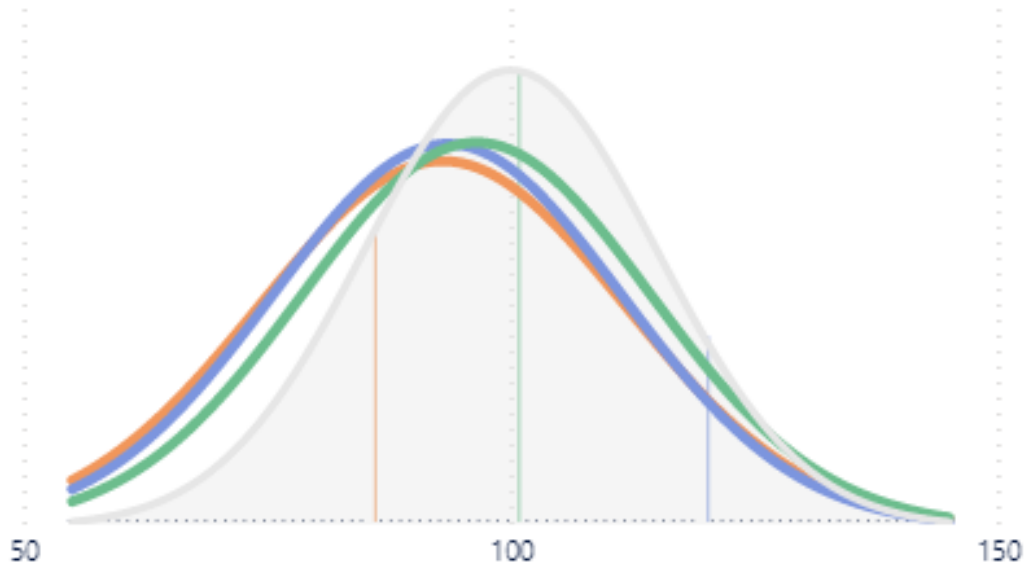
Results:

- TTT results showed growth in the areas of reading comprehension, reading fluency and efficiency (sight word efficiency and decoding) at the grade 4 and 5 levels. In grade 6 there was limited growth in the area of fluency and either no growth or negative growth in the areas of reading comprehension and reading efficiency.

2020-2021 TOSREC

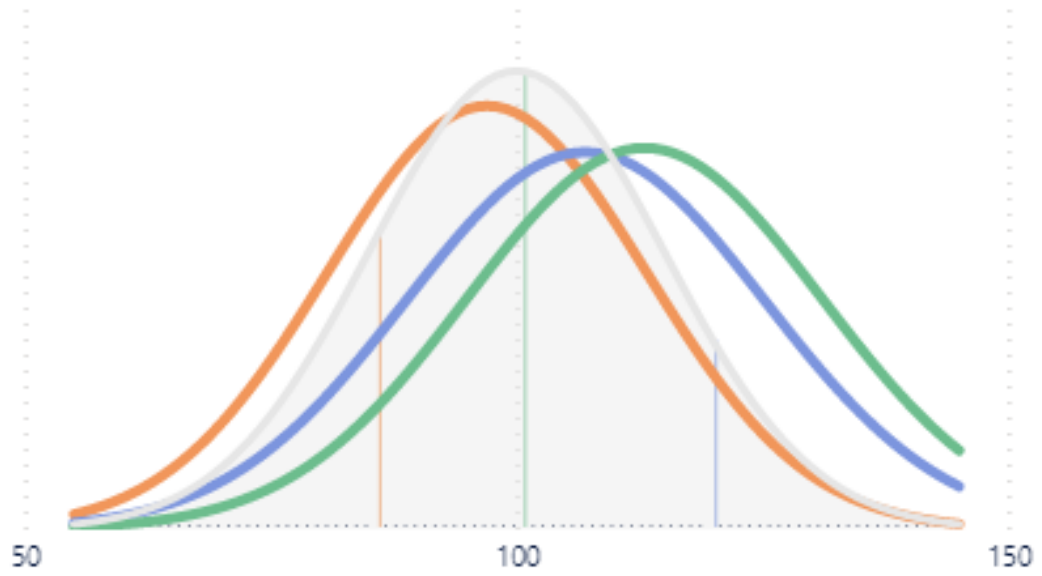


Standard Score Distribution (All Reading Tiers)



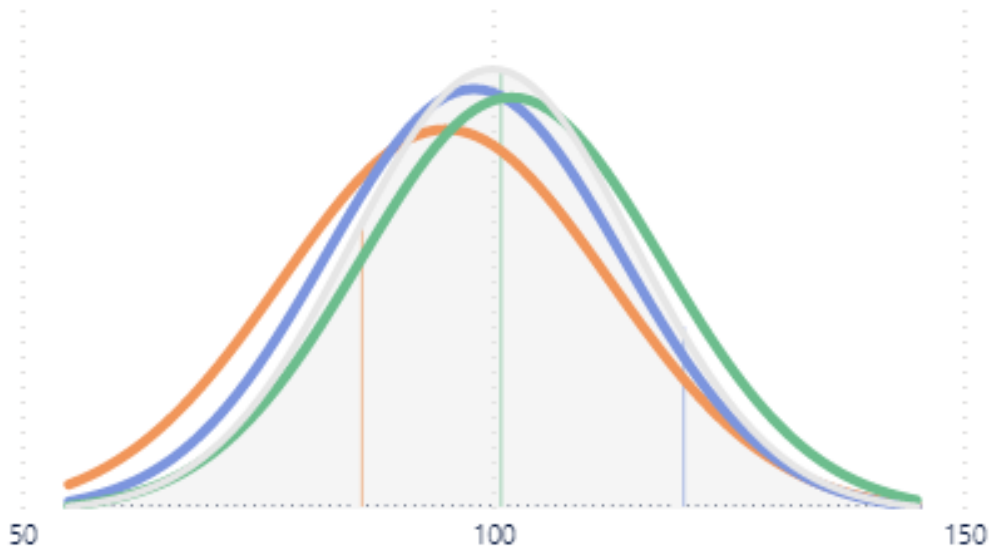

School Goal 2: All RVCS students will improve numeracy skills.

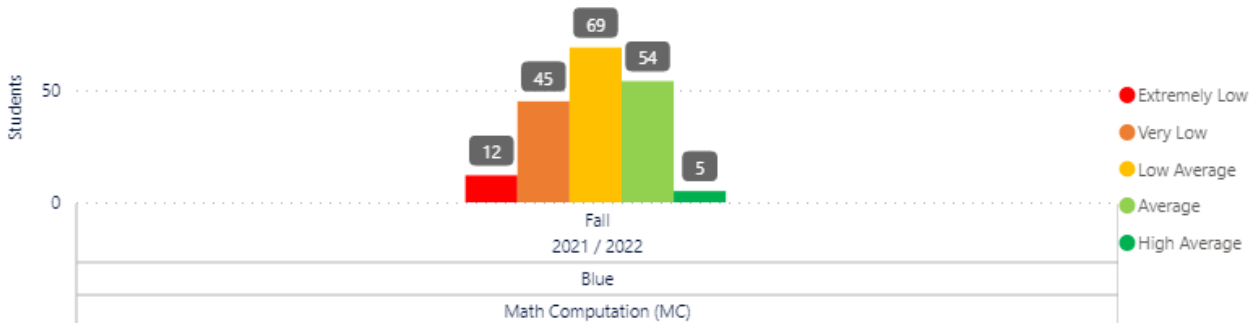
Target and Measurement Tools:

- Designated School Numeracy contact

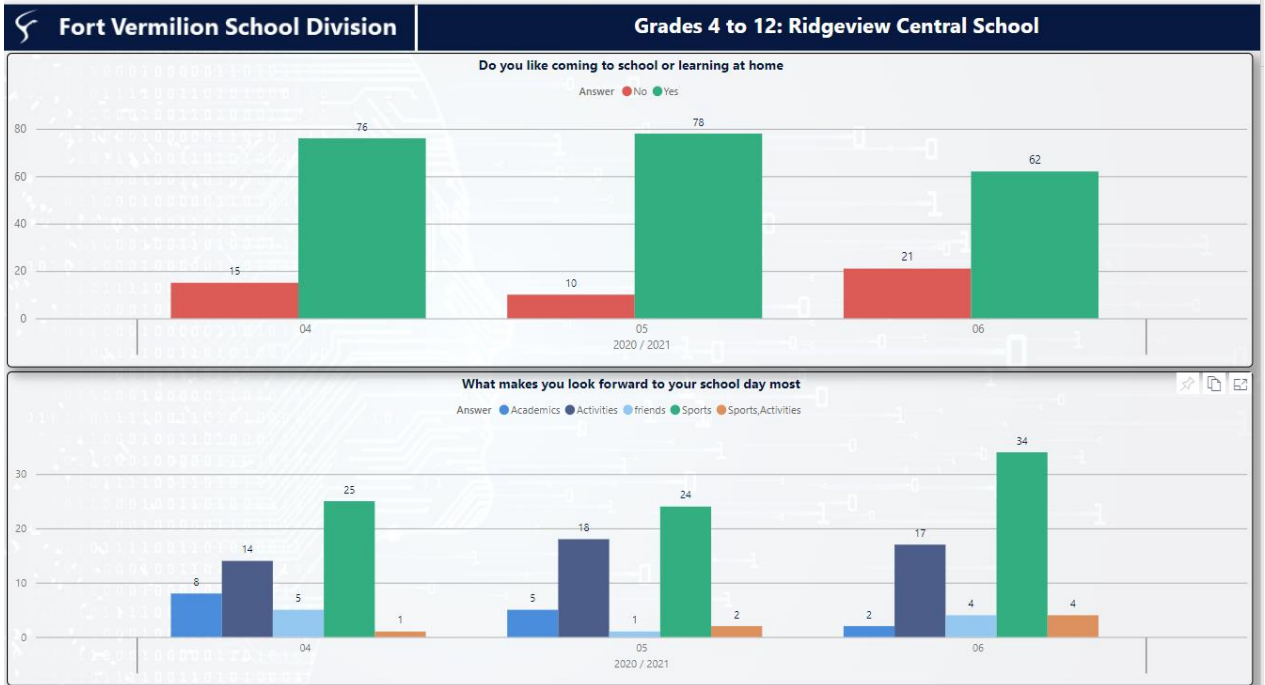
School Goal 3: RVCS will align all practices to foster connectivity and well-being among students, parents, staff and community.
