CRM teams use a goal planning document to plan for professional work to address school improvement goals.
- Regular administrative walk throughs in each classroom, with a focus on students and quality instruction.

- PNSA K-






- Weekly numeracy bulletin boards.
- Consistent implementation of division recommended resources such as Nelson Pre-Assessments, Leaps and Bounds, Jump Math K-


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
