Results:
 From Fall to Spring we saw an increase in comprehension, fluency, and word efficiency capabilities. The largest gains were in comprehension, however, this was still the lowest area overall with 43.8% of students scorin below average, compared to 31% in the other two areas.
 Plan moving forward: Shifting the goal in 2023/24 to an oral language focus in order address school wide results indicating a delay in language and comprehension skills.
 Implementing Content Coaching in which coaches will build capacity in staff in order to increase effective universa teaching strategies in literacy.
 Continue to use Empower and Best Practices in Reading interventions to support struggling students needing Tie 2 and 3 supports

Results:
 We saw an increase in median score on the WRAT from 91 in the Fall to 96 in the Spring
 31.5% of our students are still scoring below average
 Plan moving forward: Aligning our 2023/24 goal with our oral language focus by including focus on mathematical discourse Implementing Content Coaching in which coaches will build capacity in staff in order to increase effective universal teaching strategies in Mathematics
Continue to implement numeracy interventions to support struggling students needing Tier 2 and 3 supports
School Goal 3: Connectivity - All students, parents and staff will feel a sense of belonging and safety at FMCS

Results:

- 96% of students feel positive regarding how adults make them feel at school
- 86% of students feel positive regarding how peers make them feel at school
- 80% of students feel positive in their day-to-day feelings while at school
- AEA survey results from teachers indicated an overall standard of Excellent in the areas they were surveyed on (Citizenship, Education Quality, and Parental Involvement)

• Low parental attendance at School Council meetings but positive feedback from those who attended

Plan moving forward:

• Based on the low School Council attendance but positive results on surveys, in 2023/24 we are adjusting our goal to reflect the needed area of focus. Our goal will be working to ensure parents and community feel they have opportunities to contribute perspectives and connect with the school in ways that feel relevant to them.
