SCHOOL GOALS

School Goal 1: Literacy

School Goal K-12: By June 2023, 90% of all Rainbow Lake students will increase their standard score by 3-5 points as measured by the TTT (TOWRE, TOSWRF, TOSREC) data.

Target and Measurement Tools:

- K CTOPP (September & May)
- Gr. 1 TTT (January/February & May/June)
- Gr. 2-11 TTT (September, January/February, & May/June)

Results (Fall 2022 \rightarrow Spring 2023):

- TOSREC 54% of students increased standard score.
- TOSWRF 48% of students increased standard score.
- TOSWRF 72% of students increased standard score.
- Overall, students at or above average increased from 33.9% in Fall to 37.8% in Spring.

Plan moving forward:

- In the 2023-2024 school year, we have many plans for improvement in Literacy.
 - Teachers and support staff will provide interventions for improvement for students who are below average. These will run on a daily basis and will occur in cycles throughout the year.
 - Teachers will learn best practices for teaching Tier 1 and 2 students within their classrooms, making best use of our support staff to teach in small groups.
 - PD opportunities for staff Best Practices and small-group interventions.

School Goal 2: Numeracy

K-9: By June 2023, 90% of Rainbow Lake students will improve their numeracy skills by increasing their standard score 3-5 points, as measured by the WRAT 5.

Target and Measurement Tools:

- Gr. 2-9 WRAT 5 (October, February, May)
- K-9 Leaps and Bounds (assessment tools) & Nelson Pre-Assessment

Results (Fall 2022 \rightarrow Spring 2023):

• WRAT5 - 54% of students increased standard score.

Plan moving forward:

- In the 2023-2024 school year, we have many plans for our continuous improvement in Numeracy.
 - Teachers and support staff will provide interventions for improvement for students who are below average. These will run on a daily basis and will occur in cycles throughout the year.
 - Teachers will learn best practices for teaching Tier 1 and 2 students within their classrooms, making best use of our support staff to teach in small groups.
 - PD opportunities for staff Best Practices and small-group interventions.

School Goal 3: Culture/Climate

By June 2023, RLKS will provide opportunities to foster connectivity and well-being amongst students, staff, parents and the community.

Target and Measurement Tools:

• Completion of planned connection pieces throughout the year.

Results:

- Out of the 27 activities we planned for students, staff, and community members, we successfully completed 18 of them. A success rate of 67%.
- We offered more activities that we had planned for; Jump Rope for Heart, Game Nights, and Open-Gym to name a few.

Plan moving forward:

- In the 2023-2024 school year we will continue to provide more opportunities to foster connectivity and well-being amongst our students, staff, parents, and the community.
 - Our goal is to have Rainbow Lake School be a central meeting place, a popular hub for our community.
 - We realize that as a small staff, we cannot offer opportunities for everything, so we plan to invite skilled community members to help in providing extra-curricular activities at the school.
 - We plan to continue to build positive relationships with our neighboring community of Chateh.
 - We have great ideas for "House Teams" that will bring great connection between students at the school and a sense of belonging.
