4. Student Council Update:

- 5. School Board Trustee Report: Marc Beland
 - **a.** May 18th was last meeting focus on student achievement from Blue Hills and Learning Store/Home Schooling group. Dave Gallant from Blue Hills talked quite a bit about staff morale and cohesion. School expansion in September.
