TTT, WRAT/Numeracy Testing

The FVSD has a great focus on student improvement in the areas of literacy and numeracy. TTT testing tests literacy growth and takes place at the beginning of the year for grades 2-9, mid-year for grades 1-9, and year end for grades 1-9. This is done to see how students are progressing in the focused reading areas of decoding (ability to apply letter and sound patterns), fluency (speed/accuracy in reading), and comprehension (understanding what is read).

Grade 1-9 students will complete their TTT tests the first week they return to school in January.

Students also will be going through some testing to measure their growth in their Computation Ability and Number Sense. Students in grades 1-9 will be writing the WRAT and grades K-4 will be writing an additional test, the Provincial Numeracy Assessment Screener (PNSA). This testing will occur the week following the TTT tests.

Testing result data in January impacts teacher instruction and our intervention programming for the remainder of the school year.

Proper Winter Dress

With the colder temperatures upon us, we would like to remind parents to ensure that your children are properly dressed for winter weather when sending them to school. Our expectation is that students K-6 head outside for recess when the temperatures are warmer than -20 Celsius. Also, another reminder to ensure that your children's names are clearly labeled on boots and gloves to help prevent students from accidently using another student's winter gear.
