7. Principal's Report

- a. Christmas Concert- Very well attended and general consensus from parents was that it was appreciated. Special thank you to Ms. Dyck and Mrs. Paul for their leadership of the choir.
- b. Board of Trustees Report Mrs. Halladay, Mrs. McDonald, Mr. Driedger, and Mr. Fehr reported about positive school results in areas of Connectivity, Literacy, and Numeracy to the Board of Trustees on Wednesday, January 24th. The report was very favorably received from the Board of Trustees.
- c. Student Learning Focus- Literacy and Numeracy Update. Recent testing results show incredible growth in both literacy and numeracy since beginning of school year until now. We are very proud of the fantastic work done by teachers and educational assistants this year!
- d. Ski trip- Junior High- Junior High students were planning on skiing at Blue Ridge Mountain Resort on February 1st. This has been postponed due to the warm weather and lack of snow.
- e. Junior High Extra Curricular Update (JH basketball, 4-6 basketball, shinny hockey, board game club)
 - -Boys and girls basketball teams are nearing the end of their season with Divisionals happening before teachers' convention. Zones are the first weekend of May.
 - -4-6 basketball being led by Mrs. Peters and Mrs. Paul on Friday afternoons. Last week we had about 30 students participate.
 - -Shinny hockey has had a slower start this year due to the extreme weather but have had a few practices and one game.
- f. School Calendar- School year starts September 3 and ends June 6. No PD days and a shorter break around Teacher's Convention has made this possible. School days should only increase 5 minutes.
- g. School Assurance Plan- Mennonite culture presentations at REACH assemblies. Still think it's a good idea. We will continue to look for an appropriate person to share.
- h. School Expansion- Plan and Advocacy
 - -Projecting 280 or more students for 2024-2025. Mr. McMann is working on getting extra classroom space built. The ball is rolling on this, but it is a slow process.
 - -BHPS has been allocated another teacher for the next year.
 - -Mr. Fehr is currently on a teacher recruitment trip at Concordia University (January 29-31). Mr. Driedger will be heading to King's University in March.
