

After I Start

- You** will receive two years of Balanced Literacy training which will provide you with the framework used in our Division.
- You** will attend the beginning teachers conference at the end of September and be provided with numerous PD opportunities throughout the year.
- You** will be supported through supervision, evaluation, a Learning Tools Support Coach to help with all of the wonderful technology we have in our Division; if you work in Junior High you will be supported by 4 subject coordinators that will help through coaching and the development of common assessments.

At the end of your second year there will be a feedback process so that we can continue to improve our model and help you plan for your third year.

When I Start

- Fort Vermilion School Division** has a wonderful mentorship program that will keep you grounded as you begin your career in education.
- In August** you will be treated to some training in the area of Balanced Literacy, teacher induction model and, at the new teacher orientation, you will also receive a curriculum support binder for the subjects and grade you teach.
